



Hi all

Thank you for those who have gotten back to me regarding the courses and e-vetting you have completed. As incoming Education Officer this has been a huge help to get an overview of where the club is at regarding qualifications for courses and in turn helps us plan in a timely fashion for future galas. Our overall aim is to have a parent from each family fully e-vetted and qualified, particularly in the main courses which are Safeguarding, Team manager, timekeeper and turn judge.

Unfortunately, as the data comes in, it is becoming clear that the club does not have enough qualified parents. This is putting future galas in jeopardy as we may not have enough Team Managers on deck. To illustrate this point, for our upcoming gala this month (and despite a good number of swimmers entered) we barely met the required cohort of team managers. In this instance, a crisis was averted only by the fact that one parent kindly offering to double-up duties.

It is therefore beholden of me to point out that our club constitution states that all families need to provide a team manager or official with the relevant qualifications to officiate at a minimum of one gala during a season. Failure to do so will result in your swimmer not being able to attend the gala and may need to pay a €100 contribution to the club which will be used for training purposes.

These may seem harsh as no doubt you are suffering the Swim parent's syndrome of early morning training runs, endless food preparations, long days at galas, and the not-insignificant financial burden of having a competitive swimmer in the house. Don't worry, I can assure you that for this year no parent will be asked to pay the 100 contribution and your child will NOT be cancelled from galas. We are also sensitive to the fact that some of you have extenuating circumstances so please feel free to contact me or a committee member if you have an issue. Everything doesn't fall back on the parent many factors current and historic which have conspired to create the present situation, not least the e-vetting trap which is taking up to eight weeks to process and preventing us getting some team managers up and running.

However, we need to get e-vetting, safeguarding and team managers courses underway ASAP so I ask all of you who have a competitive swimmer to undertake the above courses as a matter of priority



National Vetting Bureau

Welcome to the National Vetting Bureau.

The National Vetting Bureau (Children and Vulnerable Persons) Acts 2012 to 2016 provide a statutory basis for the vetting of persons carrying out relevant work with children or vulnerable persons. The Act also creates offences and penalties for persons who fail to comply with its provisions.

The Act stipulates that a relevant organisation shall not permit any person to undertake relevant work or activities on behalf of the organisation, unless the organisation receives a vetting disclosure from the National Vetting Bureau in respect of that person.

Garda vetting is conducted on behalf of registered organisations only and is not conducted for individual persons on a personal basis.

If you are seeking employment or intending to volunteer with an organisation which conducts relevant work, you may be asked to make an application to be vetted.

You may make an application to be vetted in one of two ways:

eVetting or Paper application

Attendance at Safeguarding Level 1 Workshop (Sport Ireland)

The Safeguarding Level 1 workshop is provided for those involved in sport. The workshop is 3 hours long and the aims are by the end of the workshop the participants will be able to:

- *Implement best practice in protecting the welfare of participants.
- * Create a child-centred environment within the sports club.
- * List categories of abuse and some indicators associated with abuse.
- * Make appropriate response to a disclosure.
- * Make a report to designated person or appropriate Statutory Authorities.

A central goal for all those involved in sport for young people is to provide a safe, positive and nurturing environment where children can develop and enhance their physical and social skills.

Promoting a child-centred environment should go hand in hand with identifying and eliminating practices that impact negatively on a young person's safe and enjoyable participation in sport. Due to the very nature of this workshop you cannot consider safeguarding issues without discussing child abuse and attendees should be aware of the emotional impact this may have on them personally.

Swim Ireland requires that any 16-17-year old's obtain written permission for them to attend. The training will involve working on case study examples and scenarios. The course tutor will again outline an emotional health warning, explaining that safeguarding training can arouse uncomfortable feelings for some participants and directing them to contact numbers available on the Swim Ireland website.

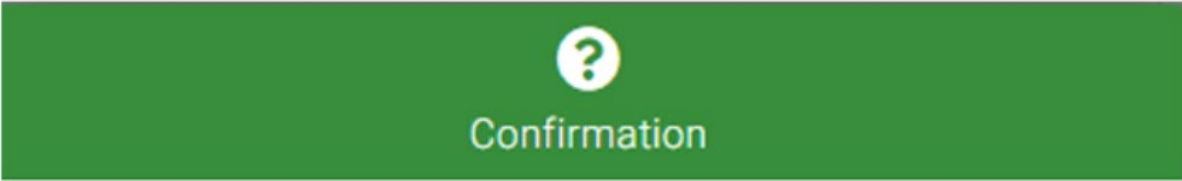
